Dear Colleagues!

On 5th June 2015 the Georgian Government took the Ordinance #255 *In approving the list of countries whose citizens can enter Georgia without a visa* and the Ordinance #256 *Affirmation of the List of the countries, people, owing Visa/Residence cards of which, can enter Georgia without Visa with Certain Date and Conditions* (enclosed).

According to the ordinances, citizens of EU countries, as well as third countries nationals, holding valid visa or residence permit of one of the countries listed in the decisions, do not need a visa (visa exemptions) to enter Georgia.

Due to the above mentioned, the Georgian Patrol Police (authority responsible for border control) has to check validity and authenticity of visas and residence permits issued by countries listed in the ordinances.

Bearing in mind mentioned above, as well as close EU-Georgia cooperation, the State Border Guard of the Republic of Latvia kindly invite You to render assistance to the Georgian Patrol Police by considering a possibility to provide information on visas and residence permits of Your countries to the Georgian Patrol Police.

Please inform the State Border Guard of the Republic of Latvia (fanx2015@rs.gov.lv) if You agree to exchange information with Georgian Patrol Police regarding visas and residence permits issued by Your country by 13th July 2015. Further details and contact information of the Georgian Patrol Police will be provided.

Ordinance of the Government of Georgia #256

5th of June, 2015

Tbilisi

Affirmation of The List of the countries, people, owing Visa/Residence cards of which, can enter Georgia without Visa with Certain Date and Conditions

Article 1.

About making changes in the Law of "Legal Status of Foreigners and Stateless people". According to the "A" subparagraph of 1st paragraph of 2nd article of the Law of Georgia (#3602-rs) of 8th of May, 2015, to be affirmed below attached "The List of countries, people owing Visa/Residence cards of which can enter Georgia without Visa but with Certain Date and Conditions".

Article 2.

The ordinance must come into force on the day of its publication.

Dates and Conditions of Crossing Georgian Borders:

1. Foreigners, who have the Visa or Residence Cards of the above listed countries, can enter Georgia without Visa and be in Georgia during 90 days within 180-days period.
2. With the purpose of crossing the Georgian Borders and Being in Georgia, the certain Visa or Residence card must be valid while coming to crossing the border and it must be confirmed with Travel or some other document.

Ordinance of the Government of Georgia # 255

In approving the list of countries whose citizens can enter Georgia without a visa

Article 1

According to paragraph 4 of article 4 and paragraph 1 and 3 of article 10 of the Georgian law of "Legal Status of Foreigners and Stateless Persons" to be approved "List of the Countries Whose Citizens May Enter Georgia Without a Visa"

Article 2

In accordance with Article 25 of the Law of "Normative Acts" declared invalid the Ordinance of the Government of Georgia # 522 01.09.2014 about the approval of the list of countries whose citizens can enter Georgia without a visa.

Article 3

The ordinance must come into force on the day of its publication

Note:

1. People owning the citizenship of the countries listed in appendix can stay in Georgia the whole year.
2. People owning the citizenship of the countries of EU can enter Georgia with travelling document and ID card issued by the EU member countries where must be mentioned person's name, surname, date of birth, also must be attached a photo.
3. People owning the travelling document (Laissez-Passer) issued by The United Nations authorized agencies and organizations can stay in Georgia the whole year.
4. The right of entering and staying in Georgia a whole year can be given to the foreigner (who needs a Visa) by the decision of Georgian Government in special occasions determined by this very decision.
