Mr. Lynn is the President of the Federation of the Israeli Chambers of Commerce and the Tel Aviv and Central Israel Chamber of Commerce. He also served as board member of Eurochambres and as a member of the council of World Chambers Federation. Prior to his presidency, amongst other leadership positions, Mr. Lynn served as Governor of State Revenues and as Director General at the Israel Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure. In 1984, Mr. Lynn was elected as a member of the Knesset, which he served until 1992. He studied law at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and University of California, Berkley, and received an LLM degree from both universities.
