## Business Delegation & Forum to Saudi Arabia 4 – 8 June 2022

We are pleased to announce that the new date of the Cyprus-Saudi Business Delegation is 4-8 June 2022.

The Cyprus Chamber of Commerce & Industry and the Ministry of Energy, Commerce, and Industry, with the support of the Cyprus – Saudi Arabia Business Association are organising a Business Delegation and Forum to Saudi Arabia (Riyadh, Jeddah) between 4-8 June 2022, aimed at the broad promotion of business relations between the business communities of Cyprus and Saudi Arabia.

## The Delegation will be headed by the Deputy Minister of Research, Innovation and Digital Policy Mr Kyriacos Kokkinos.

- 1. The focus themes for the event(s) will be set based on the interests of the Cypriot companies participating, following consultation with our Saudi counterparts. Thus, the relevant Agenda and travel information will be provided at a later stage but well in advance of the events.
