Participation in the workshop is free and open to anyone interested.

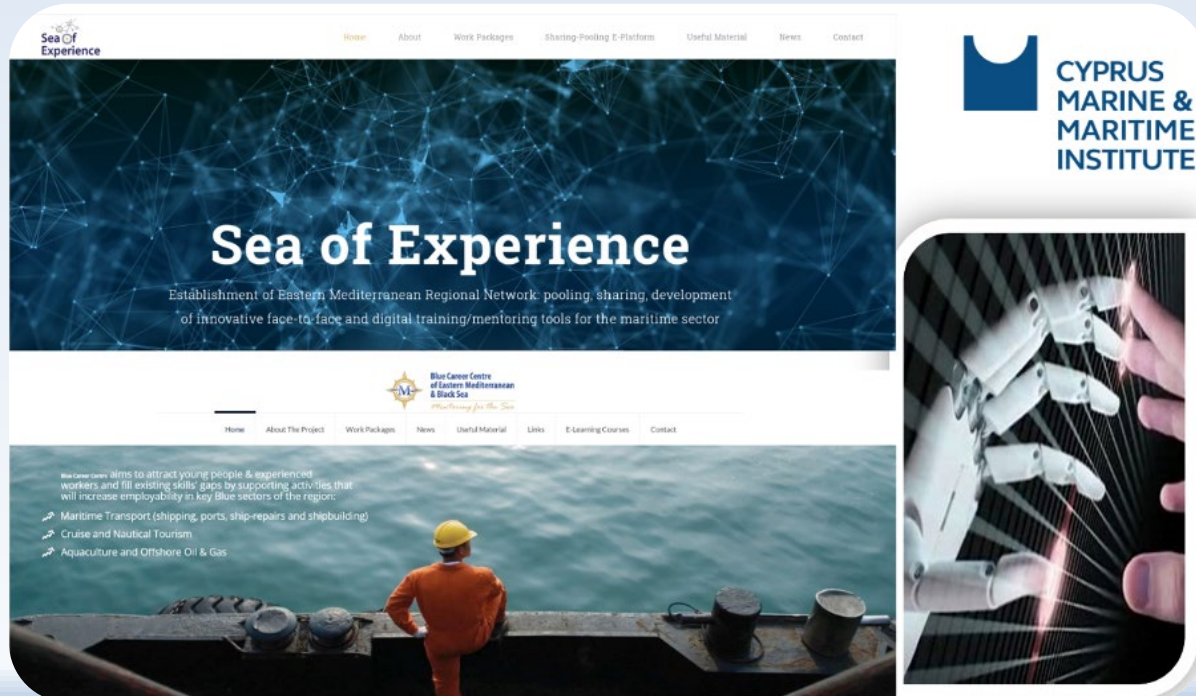
