Your Excellency,

The EU Delegation to Zambia and COMESA will organise an EU-Zambia Business Forum on "Growing the Copper Industry in Zambia through Green Value Chains" in Kitwe from the 10th to the 12th of April 2024.

It is my pleasure to now formally invite you to join the Business Forum and register through the dedicated website, if you have not done so already: https://euzcopperbf2024.com/

The programme will include panels focusing on; (i) the business environment in Zambia, (ii) the trends in copper demand and the opportunities in the copper value chain, (iii) deep-dives into the opportunities for value-addition identified in the report which inspired the forum, (iv) ESGregulations and its implications for private financial flows to Zambia. In addition, there will be three sessions dedicated to business-to-business meetings.

President Hakainde Hichilema confirmed his participation, and we expect the attendance of the invited Ministers of Commerce, Trade and Industry; Mines and Minerals Development; as well as Green Economy and Environment. The European Union will be represented by Mr Henrik Hololei, hors class advisor of the Director General of the European Commission's International Partnerships and Mr Peter Handley, Deputy Director at the European Commission's Directorate General for Internal Market, Industry, Entrepreneurship and SMEs, in charge of energy intensive industries and raw materials.

Until today, more than 200 companies expressed interest in the Forum. Yet, the number of European companies is still low considering our ambitions of forging business relations between Zambian and European companies, and ensuring that Europe benefits from the identified investment opportunities. We therefore kindly call upon you to help redouble our efforts to identify relevant European companies for the forum. For this reason, I am hoping for your additional support in promoting the forum and forwarding this invitation to relevant companies, business associations, trade promotion agencies, as well as development- and investment banks in your country.
