Αγαπητά μέλη,

Με αφορμή την επίσκεψη Επιχειρηματικής Αντιπροσωπείας από την Αυστρία, το KEBE ως συντονιστής του Enterprise Europe Network Κύπρου, διοργανώνει σε συνεργασία με την ADVANTAGE AUSTRIA, την Πρεσβεία της Αυστρίας στην Κύπρο και τον Επιχειρηματικό Σύνδεσμο Κύπρου-Αυστρίας, το Επιχειρηματικό Φόρουμ Κύπρου-Αυστρίας στις 21 Νοεμβρίου 2024, στις 10:00 π.μ., με θέμα «EU RECOVER MISSION - REPOWER CYPRUS».

Στο Φόρουμ θα πραγματοποιηθούν ομιλίες και παρουσιάσεις που θα εστιάσουν σε κρίσιμα και επίκαιρα ζητήματα για την Κύπρο, όπως η ενεργειακή μετάβαση, η διαχείριση της κυκλοφορίας, το νερό και το περιβάλλον, η πολιτική προστασία, η ανάπτυξη λογισμικού, η τεχνητή νοημοσύνη και η επιστήμη δεδομένων.

Θα ακολουθήσουν επιχειρηματικές συναντήσεις μεταξύ Κυπριακών και Αυστριακών εταιρειών, προσφέροντας την ευκαιρία για διερεύνηση και ανάπτυξη συνεργασιών καθώς και κοινών έργων στους σημαντικούς αυτούς τομείς. Για τον σκοπό αυτό, επισυνάπτεται η λίστα με τις 10 Αυστριακές εταιρείες της αποστολής, η οποία περιλαμβάνει μια σύντομη περιγραφή του τομέα δραστηριότητάς τους και των προσφορών τους για συνεργασία.

Μέσω αυτών των δράσεων, επιδιώκεται η υποστήριξη της Κύπρου στην ανάκαμψη και την ανάπτυξή της, είτε αυτό αφορά την οικονομία, την ενέργεια ή γενικότερα την κοινωνία.


